Quinten Levi Joseph Stump-Rendon passed away at home on November 8, 2019. He was the youngest child of Joe and Leslie Stump-Rendon of Satus, Washington.

Quinn was born in Toppenish, Washington on February 6, 2004, and grew up on the Satus with his family on their small ranch, and was currently a sophomore at Granger High School.
