Adam "Lefty" Schneider (84) of Wapato passed away at his home on Saturday June 26, 2021. Lefty was born in Fort Yates, ND on September 26, 1936 to Joseph and Mary (Thomas) Schneider. He graduated from Toppenish High School and served in the U.S. Marine Corps. After his service to his country Lefty went to Barber School and was a licensed barber for over 60 years. On September 29, 1962 he married Rosalie A. Fernandez who he met in high school. Lefty was a very active member of St. Aloysius Catholic Church and would go and barber shut-ins for many years. He enjoyed farming, dancing, playing his banjo, carpentry work, playing pool, hunting & fishing and going to the casino. He will be remembered as a man always looking to help those in need.
