Antonio Flores Botello of Toppenish passed away on Friday, November 21, 2025. Antonio, also known by Tony or Don Antonio, was born June 2, 1940, in El Moral, Coahuila, Mexico, to Jesus Maria Botello T. and Manuela Flores Botello.

In his younger years, Antonio and his family moved to Washington State in the 1950's in support of the agricultural work in the Yakima Valley. His family settled in Toppenish and migrated to Montana, Idaho, Texas and then back to Washington to follow the work of various crops. While living in Toppenish, he and his family lived at the Yakima Golding Farms where he then worked for more than 50 years.
