Arthur R. Picard (78) of White Swan went to be with the creator on Tuesday December 2, 2014 in Yakima. He was born in White Swan on January 4, 1936 to Emery and Nora (Gagnon) Picard. He was raised and educated in White Swan and served in the U.S. Marines from 1956 to 1959. He worked as a heavy equipment operator in the logging industry and was an enrolled member of the Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla Reservation and member of the Catholic Church. He enjoyed steam trains, antique cars, fishing at Celilo and being the mountains along with older music, western movies and he loved the sport of boxing which he participated in as a young man. He was an accomplished equipment operator who enjoyed operating a grader and plowing snow. He is survived by his companion of 29 years, Elsie Finley of White Swan; two sisters, Loretta Braden of White Swan and Lorraine Joe of Yakima; numerous nieces and nephews that he loved dearly. He was preceded in death by his parents; and four siblings, Lawrence, Louise, Emmett, and Katie.
