Austin R. McConville (33) of Yakima went home to be with his Lord and Savior on Friday August 10, 2018. Austin was born in Yakima on September 21, 1984 to Alfred and Aleatha (Whiz) McConville. As a young child Austin was prone to pneumonia and respiratory issues that put him in the hospital frequently. He was an enrolled member of the Yakama Nation who was raised and educated in Yakima and graduated from White Swan in 2003. Austin was devoted to his faith in Jesus Christ. Fishing was a huge part of his life as he worked as a commercial fisherman fishing with gill nets, scaffolds, hook & line, drift and he also did winter sturgeon tagging for C.R.I.F.C. population estimation. In his younger years he enjoyed traveling to play in basketball tournaments. He enjoyed time spent with his boys playing basketball at the YMCA. He was devoted to his children, nieces and nephews and would always take them places. He organized family dinners and loved to bbq. Austin is survived by his parents, Alfred and Aleatha McConville of Yakima; his children, Lance, Jeremiah and Austin Jr.; his companion, Channa Mark of Wapato; two brothers, Charlie Stacona of Yakima and Alfred McConville Jr. of Wishram; five sisters, Loretta McConville of Yakima, Althea McConville of Lyle, Lydia Howard and Germaine McConville both of Toppenish and Alicia F. Whiz of Wapato; numerous aunts uncles and cousins. He was preceded in death by his grandparents, William Austin and Mildred (Whitefoot) Whiz Jr. & Richard and Nancy (Albert) McConville; four brothers, Joseph, Roger and Jeremiah McConville and Chauncelor Whiz.
