He always went the extra mile to make sure they had enough to eat. In all Carl's job he was very detail oriented and safety conscience. He enjoyed seeing his camp kids and Head Start kids when they would run up to him and say Hi.

Carl enjoyed traveling the Pow Wow trail since he was a tiny tot. He always said I am dancing for those who couldn't. For the elders and his grandma's. He traveled the pow wow circuit in the Northwest, California, New Mexico, Connecticut, and even Alaska. While in Connecticut he was spotted and asked to perform a scene with other dancers for the movie Naturally Native. He was honored to represent different pow wow committees as for Treaty Day, Veterans Day and Indian Summer Warrior. He served as Head Man Judge for

the Yakama Nation Treaty Day Pow wow committee. He was a man of many talents. He beaded, did feather work, and sewed many different styles that have graced the pow wow floors. He recently began styling different types of ribbon skirts. He was honored to do a cultural presentation to diverse audiences with his parents and siblings since he was a youth.

Through this experience he has branched out to do solo cultural education. He believed in kindness and had many friends. Prior to and since word of this loss, the family has received many songs and prayers of healing, strength, and love shared. It is a testament to Squahleemah's gift and ability to have left an imprint on so many hearts. The family is grateful and hold these words of encouragement and prayer close their hearts.
