Caroline Dick (68) of Satus passed away on Monday January 18, 2010 surrounded by her relatives and friends in Toppenish. She was born in Brownstown on July 4, 1941 to Horseley Benson and Mabel Kishwalk. Caroline worked as a Teachers Aide/Cook for Yakama Tribal Headstart, a custodian for the Heritage Cultural Center and as a driver for the senior citizens program. Caroline enjoyed traditional tribal activities, Elvis, and was a true high school sports supporter of all Valley teams. A cancer survivor, she was a member of the Yakama Nation and the Satus Longhouse where she was a traditional cook and gatherer for the longhouse. She is survived by her husband, Evans Dick of Satus; five children, Roy and Warren Dick both of Satus, Howard Wahpat of Toppenish, Wendy Squeochs of Harrah and Mary Jean Dick of Toppenish; two grandchildren, Leona and Tiffany Squeochs both of Harrah; three sisters, Lucinda Miller and Darlene Benson both of Brownstown and Diane Benson of Toppenish. Dressing services will be held at 10AM Wednesday at Colonial Funeral Home. Overnight services will be at the Satus Longhouse with funeral services on Thursday at Sunrise at the Longhouse with burial to follow at the Simpson Cemetery in White Swan.
