Caroline Frueh, 86, of Wapato went to be with her family in heaven on Monday, August 4, 2008.

Caroline was the last of six children, born on July 2, 1922 to Conrad and Katherine Ditter in Grand Island, NE.

Caroline had a tenth grade education, she needed to help support the family by working in the fields. But she really wanted to go to school. During World War 2 in 1942 Caroline met and married Fred Frueh. After the war they lived in Yakima.

In 1951 Caroline relocated to Wapato with her two daughters, raising her daughters and working at Snokist Growers sorting fruit. These two things took up most of her time.

Caroline also worked at Inland Fruit and retired after 20 years of hard work. After she retired Caroline still missed the friendships that she made at Inland Fruit.

Being a mother was her most important job to her. Her family was everything. Caroline was a past member of Blue Birds, Camp Fire and Eastern Star. She was a regular member of Lower Valley Christian Singles and First Presbyterian Church of Wapato for over 50 years.

This last year with failing health Caroline moved to Garden Village in Yakima. She is survived by her two daughters Nancy (Allen) Holter of Zillah and Shirley Frueh of Yakima. One grandson Jeff Holter (Angel) and one great grandson Evan Holter all of Monroe, WA. Niece Evelyn Brown and nephew
