



## Elias "Leo" Botello

April 23, 1950 - September 13, 2024

Elias Flores Botello of Toppenish passed away after a short illness on Friday, September 13, 2024, at his home surrounded by his loving family.

Elias, also known by the name of Leo, was born on April 23, 1950, in Eagle Pass, Texas, to Jesus Maria Botello T. and Manuela Flores Botello. He grew up in Eagle Pass until the age of six when the family moved to Toppenish.

On February 14, 1975, he married Rosa (Rosie) M. Ramirez in Toppenish where they made their home and were married for 49 years.

In his younger years, Elias and his family moved to Washington State in 1956 in support of the agricultural work in the Yakima Valley. His family settled in Toppenish and migrated to Montana, Idaho, Texas and then back to Washington to follow the work in various crops. While living in Toppenish, his family lived at the Yakima Golding Farms with his family until he married Rosa. After leaving school, he worked at the Yakima Golding Farms for about 12 years after which time he began servicing trucks at Lee Gomez Trucking and later at Pistroresi Livestock Hauling. Elias then worked at Howard's Tire Factory for 25 years, specializing in front end and brake work on vehicles until his retirement in December 2014. Not content to be a man of leisure during his retirement, Elias began working for his brother Alfonso at Valley Auto Center where Leo worked until 2022. Elias enjoyed helping others in any way

he could, but mostly he loved helping his family and friends by servicing their vehicles replacing brakes, rotors, calipers, etc.

Elias enjoyed accompanying his wife to the meetings of Jehovah's Witnesses at the Kingdom Hall and he also attended assemblies and conventions helping him to have a Bible-based hope for the future.

Elias is survived by his wife Rosa of Toppenish. He is also survived by his sisters Nohemi Sanchez of Toppenish and Maria de los Angeles Velasquez of Castroville, Texas; brothers Antonio F. Botello of Toppenish, Emanuel F. (Maria) Botello and Alfonso F. (Refugia) Botello of Yakima; many nieces and nephews, cousins, in-laws and friends.

Elias is preceded in death by his parents, sisters Mercedes Garibay and Elma Cervantes; and a brother Jesus Botello, Jr.

Rosa would like to thank Rita Anaya, Johnny Sanchez, Lito Ramirez and Oscar Ramirez for their assistance in caring for Leo, which meant a lot to him and allowed him to be able to stay in his home.

A memorial service for Elias will be held on Saturday, September 21, at 1:00 p.m. at the Toppenish High School Performing Arts Center. A private burial will be held at the Elmwood Cemetery in Toppenish.
