She is survived by her three daughters, Marcella John of Toppenish, Yvonne Dahrens of Milwaukie, OR and Angela Wynne of Toppenish; five grandchildren, Charity Cantu, Sarah John, Monica Dahrens, Harlan Masqua and Raven Bell; one sister, Francis Robbins of Toppenish.
