



Rev. Elliott Dean Hull

May 1, 1945 - April 3, 2014

Pastor Elliott Dean Hull of Walla Walla, WA passed away from natural causes in Toppenish, WA on April 3rd 2014, he was 68 years old. Elliott was born in Santa Rosa, CA May 1st 1945. Elliott grew up in Woodland, CA son of Robert E. Hull and Norma L. Hull . He met his wife Linda in Woodland at a mutual friend's party and immediately fell in love with her. They were married in June of 1967 in Sacramento, CA where they supported each other through University. Elliott received his Bachelors degree in History from Sacramento State University 1969 and then attended Luther Theological Seminary St. Paul, MN where he received his Masters of Divinity 1972. Elliott was highly regarded in the church community and was very strong in his faith and spirituality. He faithfully served multiple congregations through his 42 years as a pastor. Parishes served; Janesville, WI 1973-1975; Endicott, WA, 1975-1980; Toppenish, WA 1980-1985; Palmer AK, 1985-1992; Reardan, WA 1992-1998; Walla Walla, WA 1998-2002; Toppenish WA, 2002-2014. Elliott served as a volunteer firefighter and chaplain from 1975-1992. Elliott was safety director for Nello Pistoresi and Sons Trucking Toppenish, WA from 2002-2014. Elliott loved preaching, teaching, and helping people while staying true to his faith in the word of God. There was never any doubt about his faith and he was at peace when he passed away. He had a passion for history, sports, outdoors, and being a "shade tree mechanic". He will be remembered for his boisterous laughter and ability to bring understanding and levity to any situation.

He is survived by his wife Linda Hull 67 of Walla Walla. Son Peter Hull 42 of Toppenish and three grandchildren: Mitchell 15, Conner 14, Riley 12 of Hershey PA.
