Most of his life he raised and broke horses and cared for cattle most of his life. Later he became a member of the Millionaire's club. He worked in the farm labor as well like peas, apples, hops, baling hay, before working for YN roads dept. where he learned to grade roads in the mountains and became quite good at doing that. Later he met and married Caroline Benson where they have 5 children- Roy, Wendy, Sharon(deceased), Warren and Mary Jean. Later raised Howard Wahpat as his son. When his kids went to school he was chosen as JOM president for Granger. Also a small part of the Men's big tournament in it's beginning. After 43 years of work he retired from work which also fell on their 50th anniversary. Evans was also an avid hunter, fisherman and LH singer. He was chosen as Leader for Satus Longhouse by the people. Most members knew him as "Dad".
