Evelyn J. "Zebbie" Broncheau (56) of Wapato died as a result of a motor vehicle accident west of Wapato on Wednesday. She was born in Toppenish on July 1, 1956 to Tony and Ellen (Howard) Broncheau. Zebbie was raised and educated in the Yakima Valley and at Haskell and WSU. She graduated from the Federal Police Academy and worked for the Yakama Nation Tribal Police for 10 years. She switched careers and worked for the BIA at the Indian Health Service Clinic for over 20 years as a medical records clerk and as a Community Health and PTOTS representative. She enjoyed the casino, puzzles, basket weaving, movies and spending time with her family. She is survived by one brother, Merle Broncheau; one sister, Mary Lou Broncheau both of Wapato; five grandchildren and numerous nieces and nephews that called her mom. Evelyn was preceded in death by her parents; and ten siblings. Dressing services will be Friday May 31, 2013 at 3PM at Colonial Funeral Home. Overnight services will be held at the Toppenish Creek Longhouse with a funeral at sunrise on Saturday with burial to follow at the Methodist Cemetery.
