Fredrick F. Hackner (79) of Toppenish passed away on Tuesday June 12, 2012 in Yakima. He was born in Toppenish on July 25, 1932 to Frank and Bertha (Kolb) Hackner. Fred graduated from Toppenish High School and served in the U.S. Air Force for four years. In February of 1952 he married Mildred Knight at St. Aloysius Catholic Church in Toppenish. He went to work for Boeing and lived throughout the U.S. working on the minuteman missile project. He moved back to the valley in the early 1970's to run the family farm alongside his brother, Gary.
