Gail Besel, 78, of Toppenish, WA, passed away on March 19, 2024.

Gail Esther (Sires) Besel was born in Yakima on December 3, 1945, to William and Mary (Gause) Sires. She was raised in Union Gap, where she attended school and graduated from Eisenhower High School in 1964. She then attended Northwest Nazarene in Napa, ID.

Gail was united in marriage to Conrad Besel on November 25, 1966, in Yakima. In addition to being a hop farmers wife and raising her family, she worked at Title Guarantee. She became a legal secretary in Wapato, but was known for her Bright Yellow Volkswagen Beetle, that she bought to deliver newspapers before work. She was a wonderful cook and especially enjoyed baking. She loved her flowers and spoiling her dogs. Gail was a devoted wife, mother, grandmother, and great grandmother. She especially loved all the time spent with her family. She is preceded in death by her parents Will and Mary Sires.
