He also enjoyed cheering on Washington sports teams, collecting sports memorabilia, drawing, teasing everyone. No matter the situation, you would find Gary laughing and making jokes. One of Gary's strongest traits was how generous he was. He helped his family and friends with comforting words, a place to stay or money.
