He started out as a farmer, truck driver, logging, heavy equipment operator, he was a very hard-working man with many trades and retired as a security guard at Legends Casino. Gibson "Kipp" Albert is survived by his wife, Ladine (Haney) Albert of Wapato, three sons, Mike Peterson of Toppenish, Haver Jim of Wapato and Fred Logie of Wapato & numerous grandchildren. Gibson was preceded in death by his parents and one son, Landy. Dressing services will be at the Toppenish Long House at 2PM Tuesday March 14, 2018 with overnight services following. A procession will leave the longhouse at sunrise for burial at the Black Wolf Cemetery. Colonial Funeral Home is in charge of arrangements.
