Now, many thought Gloria was angelic, but she could also be a pain in her twin's backside and could be very competitive. Sometimes she even wanted to engage in verbal and physical altercations with her when they were growing up and she was always ready to share her twin's secrets with someone.

Gloria attended grade school to high school in the Toppenish School District. In Middle School she began to blossom and discovered a love for learning. Especially in high school she proved to be a very bright and adept student and

graduated #11 in the high school class of 1966 with many honors.

Gloria attended Yakima Valley (Community) College and the University of Washington where she majored in Home Economics and Spanish.

Gloria was a very smart, beautiful (inside and out), funny, caring woman with bright eyes and a smile that would light up her face. She'd give you the shirt off her back if you needed it.
