Jeannetta E. Herrera (68) of Pendleton, OR died in Spokane on September 11, 2008. She was born in White Swan on January 23, 1940 to Raymond and Georgia (Olney) Brisbois. Mrs Herrera was an enrolled Umatilla. She was raised and educated in White Swan, graduated from St. Mary's Nursing School in Vancouver. She worked for 17 years as an RN at Toppenish Community and Yakima Valley Memorial Hospitals. She later earned another degree from Heritage College and helped start Yakama Tribal High School where she worked for 13 years. In her retirement she worked part-time at Wildhorse Bingo Hall. She moved to Pendleton in the mid 1990's. Jeannetta's hobbies were spending time with her family and quilting. She is survived by her husband, Fred Herrera of Pendleton; two daughters, Snuffy Smith of Warm Springs, OR and Jonetta Everano of Benton City; two sons, Cort Herrera of Pendleton and Freddy WarBonnett Herrera of White Swan; eleven grandchildren one great-grandchild; two sisters, Bessie Aiello and Dora Mesplie both of Toppenish.
