Jessie enjoyed listening to music and hanging out with her brother's and sister's. In her younger years she played softball for the Yakima Parks & Recreation. She also enjoyed playing school with her younger siblings, where she always had to be the teacher; and at one time, she created such a difficult Washington Assessment State Learning Test, she had her younger sister Jackie crying because it was too difficult for her to complete. She loved all her childhood story books and being read to.

As she grew older, she did some on the job training at the Yakama Nation Vocational Rehabilitation Program, where she worked under her Uncle Jerry, there she learned administrative skills. Jessie's first-born Tristan was very close with his mom, and he has that Jessie smile and little bit of her shyness. Jessie inherited her shyness from her mom and her dimples from her grandma Elaine. Jessie's younger two, Yazmin and Kayson both inherited their mom's cute features. In a 2015 Facebook post, she had a picture of herself where she wrote "Today I feel cute." She expressed a lot of love for her nephew's and niece's-Troy, Trinity, Taytum, and Kazariah. She will be dearly

missed by all of her Aunt's and Uncle's. Jessie will always be her Auntie Naya and Uncle Wally's "Bebe."

She is preceded in death by her beloved parents Sonda Ashlock and Craig Twinn.
