Yallup all of Wapato; one daughter, Beth Ann Yallup of Toppenish; five grandchildren; three brothers, Dixon Yallup of Wapato, Thomas (Kim) Yallup of Toppenish, Wallace D. (Lisa) of Seattle; three sisters, Vanessa (Clarence) Yallup of Wapato, Tammy Sue (William) Yallup of Everett, and Annette (James) Yallup-Bill of Pendleton, OR.
