Joseph (Joe) Louis Hoptowit of Toppenish 65 passed away Saturday, July 20, 2024. He was born May 26, 1959 in Chicago, Illinois. He was a member of the Oglala Lakota Sioux tribe. He was raised and educated in White Swan, Washington. Graduating from White Swan High School in 1977. While growing up he spend most of his days in the hills with his mother Eleanora (Nora) Plumlee while she was working at various fire lookouts.

Joe began working at Yakama Nation Fisheries in 1978, when he was sent for fisheries training at Shelton Jackson college in Sitka, AK and then to Humboldt State college in Arcata, CA. after the training he was employed full-time by the Yakama Nation Fisheries program, where he was an integral part of helping to restore salmon to the Yakima river basin until his retirement in 2021, after 43 years.

Joe enjoyed playing softball and basketball while growing up. He played on various teams, winning many championship and MVP's along the way. He was an avid sports fan rooting for Michael Jordan and the Chicago Bulls, along with all of the sports teams and franchises in Washington state. He enjoyed Music attending hundreds of concerts throughout the northwest and other areas. He also enjoyed collecting sports memorabilia, mainly, Michael Jordan and Kasey Kahne. Joe was known for always wearing Jordan shoes. After his retirement he spent most of his time with his dog Nakita going on trips to the ocean, hills and other adventures

Joe was preceded in death by his beloved mother Eleanora Plumlee and also

many beloved pets that he treated like family. His last and greatest adventure will be to meet up with his mother and to meet up with everyone he loved and missed in heaven.

Joe touched a lot of lives in his 65 years. He will be greatly missed by all that loved him!
