Judy D. Eyles (57) of Zillah passed away on Monday April 21, 2008 at Yakima Valley Memorial Hospital. She was born on November 26, 1950 in Minot, ND to Marvin and Rose (Heffner) Wahl. Judy was raised and educated in Great Falls, MT where she attended dental assisting school and worked at Malstrom AFB in Great Falls in the Oral Surgery Dept. She moved to Seattle and graduated from Shoreline Community College with a degree in Dental Hygiene. She moved to the Yakima Valley in 1981 and for fourteen years took a sabbatical from dental hygiene work and was the executive national sales coordinator for Amera Cosmetics. Judy served as president of the Zillah Chamber of Commerce in the 1990's and returned to dental hygiene work, working with Dr. Rodney Ellison for the last 8 years. She also has owned and operated Country Rose since 1989 moving the business to Toppenish and renaming it Alice's Country Rose in 1997. Judy will always be remembered as a very caring dental care provider that always had her patient's best interests at heart. She truly enjoyed any and all activities her grandchildren participated in, lunches with her co-workers, antique jewelry collecting, traveling with her family and reading and listening to music. She was a member of the Christian Worship Center in Zillah and had a deep faith in her Lord and Savior. Judy is survived by her husband, David Eyles of Zillah; two daughters, Elizabeth (Gerry)Sorensen of Orting, WA and Christy (Sean) Doonan of Zillah; six grandchildren, Bryanna, Jackson, Katie, Kira and Lleyton Doonan all of Zillah and Autumn Sorenson of Tacoma; one great-grandson, Christian; her

parents, Bud & Rose Bruno of Great Falls, MT; one sister, Jane (Don) Bruns of Daytona Beach, FL; four brothers, Ted, Terry(Kathy), Tim and Taggert (Jeaninne) Wahl; and numerous nieces nephews and cousins. She was preceded in death by her father, Marvin Wahl; two sisters, Joyce Kalmen and JoAnn Belanus; nephew, William Belanus; niece, Debi Bachmeier; and her grandparents.
