Kenneth (Ken) James Severson died at his home on March 18th 2023 two weeks before his 77th birthday. He is survived by his wife, Rosemary, children David, Brian (Shaleen), Dana (Anthony) and four grandchildren, Riley, McKenzie, Grady and Kaylee. Ken and Rosemary would have been married 50 years in June. Ken grew up in Seattle and graduated from the University of Washington. He spent his career working as a Certified Public Accountant and enjoyed wood working along with fishing. He had a 'one of a kind' sense of humor and wit that was unmatched. He had a joke ready for all occasions. He served with honors in the U.S. Army on the frontline of the Vietnam War.

Ken was also involved with the Toppenish Northern Pacific Railway Museum. He enjoyed helping restore trains, particularly steam engines and wooden cabooses. Ken also worked on period cabinetry for railroad pieces and equipment. He participated in the restoration of a 1930's style all wood R.E.A delivery truck. His mechanically inclined skills came in handy while working at the museum and at home.
