Leroy Hudson (71) of White Swan passed away on Wednesday May 16, 2018 at his home. Leroy was born in Moxee on October 23, 1946 to Jimmie and Helen (Yelechchin) Hudson. He was raised in White Swan and Tacoma graduating from Stadium High School. He joined the U.S. Army and served from 1967-69. He also taught the Yakama language at Heritage College and for the tribal head start. He also attended Clover Park Tech school in Tacoma.
