Lily Jean (Christiansen) Lott of Toppenish, Washington, passed away November 1, 2022. She was born January 31, 1931, in Mayfield, Utah, and was raised in nearby Gunnison.

Lily Jean graduated in Education from Brigham Young University. She made her love of reading a career and spent many years as a remedial reading teacher, helping struggling students learn to read. She married Blake Lott on December 28, 1954, in the Salt Lake City Temple. They were married for 67 wonderful years and together they raised five children.

She is survived by her husband, Blake, children Paula (Jack) Vandermark, Philip (Renee) Lott, Lisa (Russ) Kendall, Lucy (Craig) Reynolds, and Marcia (Brett) Stauffer, 30 grandchildren, and 25 great-grandchildren.
