was born in Cleveland, OH on September 6th, 1963 to Lloyd and Marian (Olney) Rabanal Sr.

In 1973, Lloyd (a Member of the Yakama Nation) moved to the Yakama Reservation with his

family where he was educated in the Wapato public school system. He later attended and

graduated from Bates Technical School in Tacoma, WA where he earned his degree as a

certified Diesel mechanic.

Lloyd was a very skilled individual, working as a Diesel Mechanic in the Construction industry

and also working as a Logger, which would be considered by most, his first love. If Lloyd had

the opportunity, he would tell you stories about his logging days that would make you smile. If

one of his stories didn't put a smile on your face, his infectious laugh would surely do the trick.

His love for construction spilled over into his personal life. He was always involved in the design

or renovation of things. He would take the time to build a patio for his sister,

re-roof the house  
for his parents, build a carport for his mom, put in hardwood floors, do tree  
removals, or build  
a fireworks stand for his sisters. If you ever needed anything, all you had to do  
was mention it  
around Lloyd and he would create a list of materials that needed to be  
purchased so he could  
get started. He loved spending time with his grandchildren and they always  
brought a smile to  
his face especially during barbeques with the family.
