Lloyd E. Rabanal Sr. (71) of Toppenish passed away on Saturday in Yakima surrounded by his family. He was born in Toppenish on July 9, 1938 to Felix and Edna (Winnier) Rabanal. 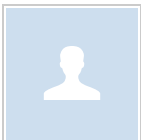
