She was fully dedicated in the Lord's prayers and loved going to shaker church meetings and being around her grandkids.

She is survived by her children, Bernard After Buffalo, Jeannie (Edward) After Buffalo of White Swan, Betty Howell of Wapato, Holly (Bernard) Gates of Arizona, adopted grandson, Eli Sampson of Toppenish and special grandson she raised Joseph After Buffalo; sisters, Shirley Sampson and Harriet Sampson Young both of White Swan, Madeline Sampson of Tacoma and Anita Lewis of Toppenish; and a half-brother, Ricky Sampson of Seattle; and numerous nieces and nephews, grandchildren, great grandchildren and great-great grandchildren.
