Emiat/Shaleen (87) of White Swan passed away Wednesday February 20, 2013 in Toppenish. She was born November 27, 1925 on the Satus to Charlie and Cahmute (Strong) Telekish. Tillie was an enrolled member of the Yakama Nation and a great teacher and leader of traditional activities. She belonged to the Toppenish Creek Longhouse and enjoyed sharing with young people how to take care of their traditional foods. She worked as a seamstress for Moxee Industries, Bailey Corporation, White Swan Furniture and retired from the Mt. Adams Furniture Company as a supervisor in the late 1970's. She enjoyed war dancing, berry picking, root digging, canning, sewing, spending time in the mountains and venturing the various casino's throughout the west. Tillie is survived by six sons, Dan Aguilar of White Swan, Raymond Kiona Jr. of Grandview, James Kiona Sr. of Bingen, Ralph and Frank Kiona both of White Swan and Greg Kiona of Priest Rapids; four daughters, Sandra Kiona of Toppenish, Beverly Lewis of White Swan, Debra Gunnier and Raemelle Kiona both of Toppenish; 31 grandchildren, 76 great grandchildren and two great-great grandchildren; one brother, Raymond Jack of Satus; one sister, Mary Goudy of Stevenson, WA; and two sister-in-laws, Margaret LaMere and Adeline Miller. She was preceded in death by her biological parents, her adopted parents, Ellen & Simon Goudy, her husband, Nelson Moses; four sisters and seven brothers.
