He later moved to Alameda, CA where he received his AAS degree in computer business administration at Heald College and worked as a computer lab technician. He relocated to Sitka, Alaska where he was employed for several years as a database technician and attended Sheldon Jackson College in business administration. Prior to his retirement he returned home to the Yakima Valley and worked for Yakama Nation Legends Casino as an auditor.

Manuel enjoyed spending his leisure time with family and friends, doing puzzles, watching his favorite football team the Minnesota Vikings, and caring for his beloved pet dog, Luther.

He is survived by his sisters Denise Root, Antonia Spencer, Manuela Spencer; brother James Trujillo; and numerous nieces and nephews. He will be deeply missed and will forever be in our hearts and memories.

He is predeceased by his parents Manuel Sr. (1970) and Delores M. (Spencer) Trujillo (1972), and brother Mitchell Trujillo (2023).
