She grew up in the Waashat Religion at the Toppenish Creek Longhouse with her parents where her dad was a drummer during services. She grew up during the horse & buggy days. She always talked about her family going around to visit various families, relatives & friends. Her dad was a hunter who always provided food to those in need. She was a well-respected elder of the Yakama Nation and the Independent Shaker Church where she was a member since she was 16 years old. As an elder of the shaker church, she traveled with family & friends to many church conventions. Their travels included Duncan, Sanish, Queets, Mudbay, Hoopa, Smithriver, Skokomish, Concrete, Muckleshoot, Warm Springs, Maalot and wherever they were needed. She enjoyed traveling to various places to see their close friends. She shared her knowledge & learnings with any new members that joined the church. She also counseled many tribal school students who confided in her about their lives. The teachings from her parents, Wehinpum & Shmaya, was carried on to many members. Her hobbies included making shawls, shell dresses, yarn belts, beadwork & gathering traditional foods. She also gathered Indian Medicine for herself and those who needed help with health issues. She enjoyed camping in our mountains (Surprise Lake) with her family for fishing & gathering wiwnu. She had a special pet named Ziny whom understood her when she spoke to

him in the Yakama Language. In her younger years, she worked with her parents in the fields. Then became employed at Del Monte Cannery for a few years until she obtained employment with the Yakama Nation Facility Management where she retired in 2003. Tumlko-pum also enjoyed traveling with her family to various pow wows to watch their family members perform. She also enjoyed traveling to visit & make new friends at the traditional stickgames which her parents loved to participate. She is survived by her son, Aaron L. (Waptushe) and daughter, Debra M.(Wehinpum) (Richard). A special granddaughter, Leanita F. (Mups, Tumlko-pum) (Jose), Ivelissa, Elohim, Ajay & Lil Marcella Orozco. Jenny Miller & her children, Martin (Snuffy), Rebecca Jo, Isaac & their children. Numerous grandchildren, great grandchildren, nieces, nephews & special relatives & friends. 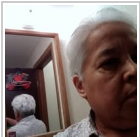
