Nicole was proudly known as a Jr. by her family, she liked to share the origin of her name Nicole, which was after her Dad Nick. She had a huge heart for animals, especially cats, she would often talk about her cat Snickers and ferrets she use to have. She was always happy to feed the stray animals she came across. 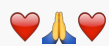
