He worked as a substance abuse counselor in Salt Lake City, UT, California and with the Yakama Nation. Raymond was a member of the Yakama Nation and a descendent of the Chehalis Tribe. He especially enjoyed working with the homeless and the Native American AA community. He was the nephew of the late Elias and Lillie Whitefoot of White Swan. Raymond was proud to carry the name of Wahshulums which was given to him by his aunt, Lillie (Yoke) Whitefoot of White Swan. This name was the Indian name of Lillie's grandfather of the Taitnapan family. He is survived by numerous relatives in Washington State. Dressing services will be held on Thursday November 19, 2009 at 10AM at Colonial Funeral Home. Overnight services will be at the Toppenish Creek Longhouse.
