Tobey, as well as 18 grandchildren, and 8 great grandchildren.

Robert McKay has always worked for the betterment of his native people and
his tribe, Dry Creek Rancheria in California. He always strived for his people,
in fact he was the 1st and only Native American to receive the State of
California Employee of the Year Award for organizing and developing a
statewide Native American Conference between the State of California and
California Tribes to establish communication to uphold and fulfill their
obligations to all Native Tribes.

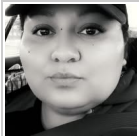
