Sadie K. Heim (98) longtime Wapato resident and owner of Wapato Florist passed away on April 30, 2010 in Kent, WA. She was born in Toppenish on August 24, 1911 to William H. and Mary Ellen (Snyder) Ritchie. Sadie was raised and educated in the Yakima Valley and on November 15, 1936 she married Alexander Heim in Wapato. She owned Wapato Florist from 1942 until retiring in 2004. Sadie will always be remembered for being an honest and fair employer to all the people that worked for her over the years. She was a member of the Wapato American Legion Auxiliary where she held several offices. She was also the Northwest District Representative for the FTD. Sadie was known for always having tea in the afternoon with whoever stopped by the flower shop. She also had a knack for making handmade braided rugs. Sadie is survived by four daughters, Peggy Heaverlo of Estacada, OR, Patty Calhoun of Renton, Rose Wilbur of Yakima and Andrea Bunker of Bothell; one son, Alexander Heim of West Linn, OR; one sister, Bonnie Reeves of Poulsbo, WA; numerous grandchildren, great-grandchildren and great-great grandchildren and nieces and nephews.
