Stella S. Pardo (78) of Wapato died at her home on Sunday May 16, 2010. She was born in Edinburg, TX on November 7, 1931 to Roberto and Leonarda (Jasso) Esparza. She married Cruz Pardo in Edinburg on January 16, 1952. They moved to the Yakima Valley in 1946 where she worked as a laborer for numerous packing plants and for Del Monte. IN 1977 started Pardo's Stop & Shop Market until retiring in 1992. Mom became a world class traveler at the age of 73, traveling to Italy, Spain, Denmark, and Morocco. One of the highlights of her life was being able to see one of Pope John Paul's last Masses at the Vatican. She and her husband also traveled to Reno and to Texas which she truly enjoyed. She is survived by her husband, Cruz of Wapato; two sons, Richard and Bob Pardo both of Wapato; two daughters, Cindi (Jaime) Tranmer of Renton and Nora Pardo of Seattle; two grandchildren, Andre Vasquez and Fred Luera and a soon to be great-granddaughter due in June; and one brother, Hector (Maria) Esparza of San Leandro, CA. Stella was preceded in death by her parents, three sisters and six brothers. Visitation will be at 4PM on Thursday at Resurrection Catholic Church in Zillah with Recitation of the Rosary to start at 7PM. Mass of Christian Burial will be on Friday May 21, 2010 at 1PM at the church with interment to follow at the Zillah City Cemetery. Colonial Funeral Home is in charge of arrangements.
