She loved yard sales, taking her dogs for walks and spending time with her family and friends. She was a sports fan, who enjoyed traveling to Seattle for games, teaching her grandchildren traditional ways, crocheting and weaving baskets. She is survived by her companion, David Lee Jack; her children, Jennifer (Horhay) Arthur, Jonathan (Rose) Spino, and Kachina (Steven) Eli and numerous stepchildren; eleven grandchildren with one on the way; five brothers, Virgil Lewis Sr, Gerald Lewis, Edwin Lewis, Evans Lewis Jr. and Galen Yallup; and a sister; Cindy Yallup. She was preceded in death by her parents and one brother. 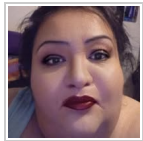
