Tashina Moutmolis Bettles, 31, was born in Toppenish Washington to Willhemina Howard and James Bettles on December 28, 1990. She is an enrolled member of the Yakama Nation and resided most of her life on the reservation but loved to travel and lived in Phoenix, AZ and Oregon. She started her journey on April 2, 2022.

As a child she traveled to multiple powwows as a jingle dancer and held the crowd for two powwows for Yakama Nation Treaty Days and Ten Day Encampment. She worked at Howard Johnson as a housekeeper, King Mountain as a harvester and migrant seasonal worker with asparagus, cherries and other produce. The work she loved was being a fisherwoman on the river. Tashina grew up loving basketball and loved to be with family and travel. Tashina is survived by her family and friends; Rachel Bettles, Raymond Bettles, Natasha Bettles, Tashina, Skylar Howard, Jessica Sermeno, Lucas Sermeno, and Shane Sermeno. Nephews and nieces: Jeremiah Cloud-Bettles, Josiah Bettles, Augustine Bettles, Angel Villegas, Barrett Bettles Jr., Andrew Villegas, Gabriela Bettles, Raven Bettles, Tru Sermeno, West Sermeno, and Noah Sermeno.

Tashina was preceded in death by her parents James Bettles and Willhemina Howard; Her sibling Barrett Bettles; Her maternal grandparents Lawrence and Ruth Howard; Her paternal grandparent James Bettles.

Her final steps to her journey will start Tuesday, April 5, 2022 with the dressing service at White Swan Longhouse in White Swan, WA starting at 10:00 AM.

Following the dressing service, overnight services will start at 7:00 PM. Services will conclude the morning of April 6, 2022, with final service before departure at 8:00 AM for burial at Toppenish Creek Cemetery in White Swan, WA.
