Trinidad Rivera Cisneros, Age 79 of Toppenish, WA passed away on Wednesday January 18th, 2023, at Astria Toppenish Hospital. Trinidad was born January 30, 1943, in Rancho del Ahijadero Aquila, Michoacan Mexico to Emiliano and Adelina (Cisneros) Rivera.

Trinidad came to the United States for a better life with his wife Consuelo Chavez, six kids and one on the way. They settled in Wapato, WA in 1977. He helped many people with whatever he could because he remembered how hard it was when they first settled in the United States. He loved playing cards, watching boxing fights and any opportunity he got to be around family and friends, he cherished. If you invited him he would show up with his Bud Light and a smile on his face. Don Trinidad was well respected and loved by many. If Don Trino walked into a room, you knew, because everyone would get up to Saludar a Don Trino. He always had a seat saved for him wherever he went. He will be missed by many family, and friendships that he created in his 79 years of age.

Don Trinidad moved to Toppenish in the early 2000's where he spent the rest of his years with his wife Eduvina (Valdovines Ramos) Rivera whom he loved

and cared for very much. They enjoyed dancing and BBQ's at any Family and Friend functions they would get invited to. He also pushed himself to work towards and eventually received his Citizenship which he was very proud of. He was grateful for the life this Country blessed him to have.

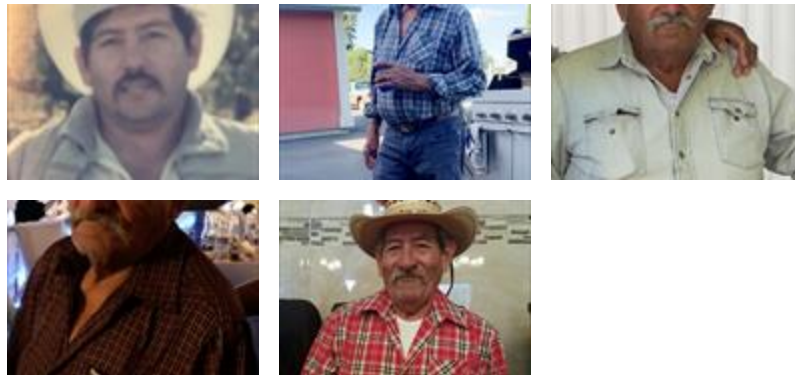
