August 10, 1914 - March 30, 2008

Val A. Sak (93) of Toppenish passed away on Sunday March 30, 2008 in Toppenish. He was born on August 10, 1914 in Portland to Albert and Anna (Kuhn) Sak. He worked in the shipyards in Portland during WWII and moved to the Yakima Valley in the mid 1940's. He worked as a nurseryman after moving back to Toppenish. He went into partnership with John Pritchett where they owned and operated Sak & Pritchett Nursery outside of Toppenish retiring in 1997 at the age of 82. Val enjoyed hunting as a young man, fishing and traveling to Reno with his daughter. Mr. Sak was a member of St. Aloysius Catholic Church in Toppenish. He is survived by two sons, Lennie and Thomas Sak both of Toppenish; five daughters, Rosanna Long of Battleground, WA, Donna Blakesley of Lynnwood, WA, Louella Templeton of Spokane, Laura Van Doren of Edmonds and Louise Long of Vancouver; 26 grandchildren and numerous generations of great-grandchildren.
